

Windows 7 Logon Screen Rotator – Change Log

2.1.0.2

- Ability to disable the history option.
- Added image view, option to select either that or list view.
- Bug fixed: Under some situations the history would not save correctly.
- A few minor bug fixes.

2.0.0.2

- Bug fixed: The setting for “Disable Other Users Changing Settings” would alternate each launch.

2.0.0.1

- Added the option to now only allow one user to change the program settings.
- Ability to change the logon screen each time you lock your computer.
- No need to click Enable and Exit, simply exiting the program will enable the program.
- A history is now kept of your logon screen changes.
- The button set may now be changed.
- Minor bug fixes.

2.0.0.0

- Well, what an update! We are now at version 2 due to the large number of changes made.
- You can now add as many images and folders as you like for the program to rotate through.
- The UI has been changed and cleaned up.
- The program will now use less memory, take up less space and run faster.
- There was a bug that would most likely crash the application if you chose an image that was too large, this has now been fixed. The resizing process as a whole is much better.

1.0.0.2

- I was planning to include more features in this build, but they have been pushed to the next release. I have pushed this build because a bug was found that would most likely stop the program from working correctly if Windows was not installed on the 'C' Drive.
- There is now a "Remove" button to remove images from being used by the program.

1.0.0.1

- Mostly code and minor bug fixes.
- The program will now resize images that are too large automatically.
- Added "Current Screen" and the ability to lock the workstation to check the screen.
- Added "Change" to change the screen on an interval of the users choosing.
- Integrated the remove files and settings into the main program.
- Ability to check for updates.
